eJBCC - JBCC ELECTRONIC SERVICE

Thank you for your continued support on the use of the JBCC Electronic Service.

The Service has entered its 5th year of operation, and proves to be an exciting year ahead with the release of JBCC Edition 6 within the next few months. These documents will be available to subscribers in electronic format as soon as they are approved and released. Monthly subscriptions will remain unchanged, as they have for the last 4 years.

In terms of our extended agreement with JBCC, various changes have taken effect as from 1 December 2010.

1. The service name has been rebranded to e-JBCC from JES.
2. Monthly subscription debit orders will be invoiced directly through Contracts on Demand and invoices will be sent electronically to Subscribers on a monthly basis.
3. A new application has been released within the service for the calculation of Contract Price Adjustment Provisions (CPAP), at no additional cost to subscribers. Indices are automatically imported into this CPAP application. The benefit for users will be a huge time saving, in not having to manually input indices into the various workgroups. It provides for rollup of CPAP into the current certificate.
4. JBCC will now directly release CPAP indices in terms of their contractual agreement with Statistic SA. Contracts on Demand will still issue indices in electronic format, for use within our applications, however access to these will be restricted on the proviso that users also subscribe independently to the JBCC CPAP Service. Current Subscribers will still receive indices in the old format through e-JBCC until expiry of their existing contracts. Access to the archive of historic indices will still be provided by Contracts on Demand as part of the e-JBCC Service.

We are confident that the e-JBCC Service will continue to provide subscribers with real value for money.
